### WEDNESDAY, JUNE 11

**Somerest Mall** — Works by members of the Detroit Society of Women Painters and Sculptors will be at the mall through June 21. There will be oils, watercolors, acrylics, glass, metal and clay sculpture. This is the 77th year the organization has given an exhibition by its members — no fly-by-night, this one. Instead, a long standing group with some excellent professionals showing their recent output.

### CONTINUING SHOWS

**Galerie de Botoeur** — World traveler Robert Duff of Birmingham brings a collection from South America called "Bolivian Highland Weaving." The collection includes both antique and contemporary textiles. Duff will be at a reception 4-7 p.m. June 6 and will give a talk at the gallery at 1 and 5 p.m. He graduated from Michigan State University and has traveled extensively in the Andes since 1970. Prices range from \$15 to \$2,000. Gallery hours are 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tuesdays-Saturdays, 315 Fisher Building, Detroit.

**Little Gallery** — Peggy deSalle closes out the season with a fine group show that will run through June. Some of the artists represented in this one are John Bearden of the Oakland University art staff who's large contemporary works contrast dramatically with more traditional works by Eve Sylvig of Bloomfield Hills and Fred Sinper, also from this area. Along with this combination are some colorful, large batiks from Denmark. Gallery hours are 11 a.m. to 6 p.m. Tuesdays-Saturdays, 915 E. Maple.

**Heritage Art Gallery** — Abstract expressionist oils and acrylics by Nora Chapa Mendoza of West Bloomfield will be on exhibit at this Ypsilanti gallery through July 19. The artist studied at Center for Creative Studies, Madonna and Mercy colleges and the Birmingham Bloomfield Art Association. The gallery is in a renovated 1860s mansion, the Old Town Hall. It is at 300 N. Huron in the heart of the historic district. Hours are Monday-Friday, 10

a.m. to 6 p.m., Saturday, 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. Reception to meet the artist June 1, 1-5 p.m.

**Halted Gallery** — Photographs by Marsha Burns will be at the gallery until July 12. The artist deals with issues of history, sex, society, fashion, psychology and light. Her work is in the collections of the Museum of Modern Art, Seattle Art Museum, Minneapolis Institute of Art and the Denver Art Museum. Gallery hours are Tuesday-Saturday, 10 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

**Yaw Gallery** — Coptic Textiles from the 5th through 12th centuries are at the gallery through June 11. There is an interesting history behind these rare framed fabrics. Textiles of this age are extremely rare. These survived because of their role in ritual burial and the dry climate. Hours are 11 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Tuesday-Saturday, 550 N. Woodward.

**Susanne Hillberry Gallery** — Paintings and pastels by Elizabeth Murray will be at the gallery through June 21. Reception to meet the artist 2-6 p.m. Saturday. Hours are 11 a.m. to 6 p.m. Tuesdays-Saturdays, 555 S. Woodward.

**Feigenson-Rosenstein Gallery** — Oil paintings by Marianne Stikas will be at the gallery through June 28. Reception to meet the artist, 4-7 p.m. May 30. Gallery hours are 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tuesdays-Saturdays, Fisher Building, Detroit.

**First Federal Savings** — The bank's Birmingham branch has a special Michigan Week exhibit of work by Michigan artists through the end of the month. 
