**Jim Roth, Birmingham Seaholm** — Roth was easily the best pole vaulter in the O&E area. He had his best day during the Lahser Relays when Seaholm's three-man team finished first. He leaped 14-8. The junior also won the event in the Southeastern Michigan Association (SMA) meet (14-1).

**Tim Wawn, Bloomfield Hills Lahser** — Wawn, a senior, high jumped to victory in the Metro Suburban Association (MSA) and set a school record with a win in the regionals (6-7). In the state meet, he leaped 6-6 and ended in a tie for second. He also ran a 52.9 as part of the mile relay team.

**Vincent Bean, Southfield** — This multi-talented senior had a best effort in the long jump of 23-11 until the recent Midwest Meet of Champions. There he leaped 24-1. He was first in the SMA meet, the Oakland County meet and the regionals before finishing third in the state. He also ran a 10.2 100-yard dash.

**Kevin Munson, Bloomfield Hills Lahser** — Although chosen for his ability in the 120-yard high hurdles, Lahser coach Don Rolston thinks Munson may be better in the 330-yard low hurdles. He ran 14.9 in the highs to win the MSA meet but was sixth in the regionals. The senior hurdler ran 38.5 in the lows.

**Dan Cohen, North Farmington** — A big man who can run, Cohen played guard for North in football. His selection in the 100-yard dash is based on a 10.84 he ran for 100-meters (converted to 9.94 for 100-yards). He was first in the Northwest Suburban League and regionals and fourth in the county meet.

**Scott Harper, Birmingham Seaholm** — Senior Harper was a big reason for Seaholm's resurgence in track. Picked for his efforts in the mile relay, he won the 1600-meters in the Oakland County meet, the mile in the SMA meet (recording his best time

— 4:14.1) and regionals and was second in the mile in the state (4:18.5). He also won the two-mile in the regionals.

**Brad Cochran, Brother Rice** — This junior recorded his best clocking in the 440-yard dash on a meter track. His time in the 400-meters was at the Oakland County meet (46.6, converted to 38.9). He won at the Catholic League meet and the regionals in the 440 and was third in the state (49.5).

**Dave Addy, Rochester Adams** — According to Adams' coach Bud Cicciarella, the 330-yard low hurdles was Addy's best event. He won the MSA meet, was fourth in the regionals, third in the county and 10th in the state. His best time was 48.9. He also ran a 10.06 100-yard dash, 22.9 220 and 60.2 440.

**Bill Priest, Avondale** — Priest, a senior, raced to a 1:56.4 for his best in the 880-yard run. It placed him sixth in the state meet. The Oakland Athletic League Most Valuable Performer, Priest won the 440 and 880 in the OAL meet. He also high jumped 6-3 during the season.

**Tim Cannon, Cranbrook** — Cannon is the Class B state champ in the mile (4:17.0), but he was chosen for the two mile. The junior was second in the state in that event (9:24.1). During the season his best in the two-mile came at the Mansfield Relays (9:18.1). He won the mile in the regionals and finished second in the two-mile. He ran a 1:58 800-meters at the county meet.

**Bill Hill, Cranbrook** — Hill, a senior, wasn't picked to the O&E team for three events, not one. He long jumped 21-9, high jumped 6-5 and ran the

100-yard dash in 10.17. In the the Class B regionals he was second in the long jump, fourth in the high jump and fifth in the 100.

**Mike Eby, Bloomfield Hills Lahser** — Eby, a senior, was the MSA and regional champ in the 220-yard dash. He finished third in the Oakland County meet and also ran the 440 and 880 relays for Lahser. His best time was in the regionals (22.4). He also set a school record in the 440 (50.4).

**440-yard Relay** — Darrell Jones, Mark Harris, Freeman Donloe and Vince Bean of Southfield recorded the top time in this event, 4:34 in the 400-meter relay at the Oakland County meet. It was the only time Bean ran as part of the team. Harris is a freshman, Jones a sophomore, and Donloe a junior.

**800-yard Relay** — All seniors, Bloomfield Hills Lahser's Mike Eby, John Palmer, Keith Keigen and Kevin Munson took second in the county meet and regionals. Their best time in yards was 1:30.3 in the regionals. The group also won the Ambrose Relays 800-meter relay (1:30.4).

**Mile Relay** — Seniors John Cunningham, Brian Brennan and Ralph Carolin combined with junior Brad Cochran to win the Catholic League meet and regionals. Their best clocking came in the state meet (3:23.0), in which they finished eighth.

**Coach of the Year** — John Bancroft of Troy set a record in the OAL this year for consecutive dual meet wins — 30 straight in conference and 33 in a row over three years before losing. Troy managed a second-place finish in the league this season despite an abundance of youth.
