

# Dressage ribbons head north

You can't say they weren't warned. Just prior to the Detroit Dressage Show, held Saturday and Sunday at the Bloomfield Open Hunt Club, most of the publicity was aimed at the participation of Cristolot Hanson Boylen, a member of the Canadian Olympic Dressage team.

You might say a lot of it was on the order of "The Canadians are coming, the Canadians are coming."

Well, the Canadian came — and went with the lion's share of the blue ribbons. Boylen lived up to her advance billing, winning seven blue ribbons in dressage.

She also rode off with both of the feature events, winning the Col. I.L. Kitts Trophy on Saturday and the Grand Prix de Dressage on Sunday.

Boylen won both events aboard Casius, who had a little more than a "lean

and hungry look" going for him. Boylen also won three events on Wil-drose and two on Dior.

Carole Grant of Hartland, one of the area's top riders, finished second on Percy III and third on Plast in the Col. Kitts competition. Grant also was second in the Grand Prix aboard Plast.

Grant won two blue ribbons on other events riding Percy III.

Local blue ribbon winners included Curtis Sake of Bloomfield Hills on Sunny, Sarah Zimmerman of Birmingham on Solitaire, Andrea Claes of Rochester on Canadiana Suite, and Karen Hunchberger of Plymouth on Ariel.

## Jumpers next at 'Open Hunt'

The Motor City Horse Show for hunters and jumpers, now in progress at the Bloomfield Open Hunt Club, gets into full swing Saturday with the featured \$5,000 Classic.

Riders in the Classic are required to negotiate a course that may include 12 to 14 jumps from 4 feet 3 inches to 5 feet 3 inches in height.

Also featured Saturday evening will be the Wayne State University Challenge Trophy for jumpers.

Topping the list of competitors is Cindy Carlson of Ann Arbor. Carlson has ridden Ruth Everett's 8-year-old gelding Cheers to a spot among this year's top money winners on the national Grand Prix circuit for open jumpers. Carlson and Cheers finished third in a \$10,000 jump-off held May 29 in Devon, Pa.

Competition in the show rings at East Long Lake Road is now in progress, starting at 9 a.m. daily. Evening programs are scheduled for Friday, Saturday and Sunday at 7:30 p.m.

General admission is \$3 daytime, \$4 evenings, or \$7 any daytime for a family carload.

## Lynch stays unbeaten with 2 wins

Birmingham Lynch and Sons grabbed wins Friday and Monday to remain undefeated in the Pontiac International Baseball League. Rain washed out Saturday and Sunday contests.

Lynch and Sons is one of only two teams still unbeaten in the tough 12-team circuit.

The Birmingham squad stopped a tough Waterford Group One club 8-2

last Friday behind the six-hit pitching of Central Michigan University ace Mark Fellows. Fellows pitched over some shaky defensive work in the sixth inning to record the easy win. He struck out nine and walked four.

tack Friday with a homer and two singles, good for five RBIs. Chuck Wagner, off the University of Michigan team that made it to the College World Series, and Bill Hyde had two hits apiece. Ed Lynch drilled a two-run homer in the first inning as the Birmingham squad scored five times before anyone was out.

Price's three-run homer in the sixth

capped the scoring.

**MONDAY, LYNCH** and Sons cruised to an easy 10-1 win over the Pontiac Met Club, putting the team's record at 1-0.

After the Met Club scored in the first inning of Monday's game, Lynch and Sons came back to take the lead with four runs in the second.
