For those who would rather go further for their fun, a trip for the whole family to Bob-Lo Island will take place on Aug. 1. Bus leaves local recreation centers at 9 a.m.

Summertime is also baseball time. For the child who wants to pitch, hit and run, the Farmington area pitch hit and run competition is slated for 10 a.m., July 12 at Farmington City Park, Power and Shawawasee.

Participants will be placed into a boys' division and a girls' division. Each division has six age groups. Participants may register at the parks and recreation office in Farmington Hills, Novi and West Bloomfield as well as participating Burger Kings in those cities. No fee is charged, but registration must be completed by July 9.

If your child would rather sit around the old campfire than run around the baseball diamond, there are several camping programs offered.

"Camp-Us" is designed for nature lovers from 9-12 years old who want to be involved in animal study. Animals, insects, geology and plant life as well as camp crafts, nature lore, archery, campfire programs, fishing and field trips are available.

Campers should bring a bag lunch and appropriate outdoor clothing such as rainwear, waterproof boots, long sleeves and pants. Transportation to and from the camp site is the parents' responsibility.

THIS CAMP PROGRAM will be open from 9:30 a.m.-3:30 p.m., Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday and from 1:30 p.m. Thursday on Oakland Community College's Orchard Ridge Campus. The Thursday segment includes regular activities as well as an evening picnic and campfire program with the camper's family. Each family will be responsible for their own picnic meal and beverage on this evening.

Sessions are scheduled as follows: from June 23-27, from July 7-11, from July 21-25, Aug. 4-8. Fee is \$25.

"COM-ON-A-WONNA" CAMP provides children 6-8 years old with the opportunity to participate in local nature oriented introductory day camping experience. Camp activities include nature lore, fishing, archery, hiking, camping programs and a field trip.

Campers should bring a bag lunch, beverage will be provided. Appropriate clothing is advised. Transportation to and from camp is the parents' responsibility. Camp hours are as follows: from 9:30 a.m.-3:30 p.m., Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday and from 1-7:30 p.m. Thursday. Thursday's program will add to regular activities with an evening program with the camper's family.

Each family should bring their own

picnic meal and beverage. Sessions are as follows: from June 30-July 3, \$20 fee; July 14-16, \$25; July 29-Aug. 1, \$25 fee; Aug. 11-15, \$25. Oakland Community College's Orchard Ridge campus will be the camp site.

SONGS, SWINGS AND LOTS of fun things camp is designed for children 4-5-years-old. Campers participate in outdoor playground and gym activities, creative games, craft projects, songs, dramatics and a field trip. Counselors will supervise. Camp will be conducted from 1:30 p.m., Monday, Tuesday and Thursday and from 10 a.m.-3:30 p.m., Wednesday, field trip day. Camp site is Alameda Elementary School, 32400 Alameda, south of 11 Mile on Power.

Sessions will be from June 23-26, \$20 fee; June 30-July 3, \$17 fee; July 7-10, \$20 fee; July 14-17, \$20 fee; July 21-24, \$20 fee; July 28-31, \$20 fee. Snacks will be provided each day except Wednesday, field trip day. Campers must bring a bag lunch for field trip day. Beverage is provided. Transportation to and from the camp site is the responsibility of the parent.

FOR YOUTH WHO like the water, swimming and diving instruction will be offered on different levels from beginning to advanced at Farmington and North Farmington High Schools. Register at the school you will attend. Pre-registration is necessary.

Each two-week instructional session consists of daily classes Monday through Thursday. You may register for only one session at a time.

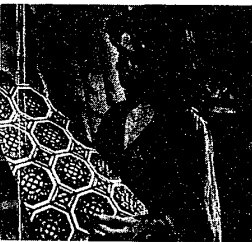
Session 1 runs from June 23-July 3. There is a \$15 fee. Registration starts from 10 a.m.-noon, June 14. Session 2 is slated for July 7-17. There is a \$15 fee. Registration is from 9 a.m.-noon, July 3. Session 3 is slated for July 21-31. There is a \$15 fee. Registration is from 9 a.m.-noon July 7.

Class times for all levels are: 9-9:50 a.m., 10-10:55 a.m., 11-11:50 a.m. Beginning diving is from 11-11:50 a.m. Levels 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 are from noon-12:50 p.m. Intermediate diving is from noon-1:50.

Suits and towels must be furnished by participants. Persons with long hair require swim caps. Open swimming requires all children to be accompanied by a parent if their chin height is below 38 inches. Children must be 38 inches at their chin height to take lessons. Cutoffs aren't allowed; swim suits must be worn.

The parks and recreation department will provide the opportunity for youths 7-17 years old to be on the department's swim team. This team isn't highly competitive. Members will be learning to compete in official swimming events, training to become stronger swimmers and gaining the experience of swimming on a team. Participants needn't be strong swimmers.
