RENEWAL OF ONE-QUARTER (¼) MILL FOR THE PURPOSE OF  
ACQUIRING, DEVELOPING AND MAINTAINING PARKS AND  
RECREATION AREAS IN OAKLAND COUNTY, MICHIGAN

"Shall the constitutional tax limitation on the total amount of general ad valorem taxes which may be imposed each year for all purposes upon real and tangible personal property in Oakland County, Michigan, be increased as provided in Section 6, Article IX of the Constitution of Michigan for a period of five (5) years from 1982 to 1986, both inclusive, by one-quarter (¼) mill, twenty-five (25¢) per One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars of the assessed valuation as finally equalized for the purposes of acquiring, developing, operating and maintaining parks and recreation areas in Oakland County, Michigan? (such increase being a renewal of the one-quarter (¼) mill increase which expires in 1981)?"
