Free bus and train rides for a year are the top grab in an essay contest co-sponsored by the Southeastern Michigan Transportation Authority (SEMTA).

The writer of the best maximum 25-word piece on coping with high prices will also get a free private screening of the movie, "How to Beat the High Cost of Living."

The winner may invite up to 50 friends to the movie. SEMTA will provide the winner and guests a bus ride to and from the screening as well as pick up the theater tab for refreshments.

The contest also offers 100 second prize winners a free monthly SEMTACARD, the authority's discounted pass.

THE CONTEST is co-sponsored by Filmways, distributor of the movie which stars Jane Curtin, Jessica Lange and Susan Saint James as three housewives driven to distraction by spiraling prices.

"It's (the promotional contest) a joint venture," said Joan Kolodziej, of SEMTA's marketing department. "It helps them (the distributors) too."

Free rides, too

"From time to time, we do have promotions to call attention to our service... we need to market our services as much as any company that sells a product."

Results of the contests, Ms. Kolodziej said, "are nebulous. You can't say we get 10 new riders because of this."

Because a small percentage of the total metropolitan area population rides SEMTA buses, she said, "We clearly want our names in front of the community."

The contest is primarily targeted toward existing riders through a monthly SEMTA publication available on buses and commuter trains, but "anyone is eligible to enter," said Ms. Kolodziej.

ALSO PART of the promotion will be a week of "mystery riders" on buses. If the mystery rider, one of 10 celebrities from Detroit television and radio stations, is spotted, all the riders on the bus will get two free tickets to the movie.

Mystery riders will be on the buses for a week starting July 25.

Contest entrants must write, in 25 words or less, their ideas for fighting inflation.

Entries must include name, address and telephone number and be addressed to: How To Beat The High Cost of Living Contest, SEMTA, 600 Woodward Ave., Detroit, 48226.

Deadline for entries is July 25. Contest judges will include a panel of local celebrities and consumer experts.

SEMTA employees, suppliers and their immediate families are ineligible for the contest.

State to air M-24 plans

Proposals for reconstruction of 1.5 miles of M-24 in Oakland County will be aired at a public hearing at 7:30 p.m. July 24 in Lake Orion.

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) hearing will be in the Lake Orion High School cafeteria, 455 E. Scripps Road.

M-24 is four lanes, undivided, from Clarkston in Orion Township to Elizabeth Road in Lake Orion.

MDOT has proposed five reconstruction alternatives, ranging from \$3.9 million for widening to five lanes to \$7.9 million for a six-lane boulevard.

Brochures explaining the proposals are available free at the Lake Orion Village Hall, 21 E. Church Street, and at the Orion Township Hall, 2525 Joslyn Road.

Informal meetings with MDOT representatives regarding the project will be held in Lake Orion Village Hall at 3 p.m. and 7 p.m. Thursday, July 17.
