

Four-year college established here

A new four-year college, associated with Touro College in New York, will be established in South Oakland County in September 1980.

The new college, made possible by a gift from Norman and Esther Allan of Farmington Hills, will be called Norman and Esther Allan College/Touro.

"Founding of the college was celebrated at a recent reception in Oak Park. Touro president, Dr. Max Landers, and Dr. Max Celnic, assistant to the president were present.

The college will function temporarily from facilities at Midrash College of Jewish Studies on 12 Mile in Southfield and the Young Israel of Oak Woods in Oak Park.

Allan, who will serve as chairman of the board of the college, reaffirmed a commitment to fund one half of the anticipated budget of the coming year as well as a long term pledge to raise \$1 million.

A portion of this money will be set aside as a scholarship fund for needy students.

ALLAN, a diamond importer whose business is headquartered in Southfield, has long been a staunch supporter of educational causes.

He is a founder of the Technion University, the Weizman Institute, and the Ben Gurion University, all in Israel, a major contributor to the Albert Einstein College of Medicine in New York, and a benefactor of the Sally Allan Alexander School for Girls in Detroit.

Born in Milwaukee 1912, he attended La Salle Institute in Chicago and the Gemological Institute of America.

Esther Allan was born in Poland in 1914 and was educated in the London Royal Academy of Music and the Scottish National Academy of Music.

A concert pianist, a composer and a writer, Mrs. Allan is active in communal affairs. She was cited by the Women's Division of Israel Bonds in 1973 and by the Jewish National Fund in 1963.

SHE WON a special citation from the Women's Association of the Detroit Symphony in 1982.

The Allans recently established the Department of Gerontology at Touro College.

In the first year of existence the school will offer programs in Judaic studies for adults and special programs for immigrants. Traditional programs for students of all ages will be offered as well, according to Celnic.

Midrash College has offered the use of its 35,000 volume library to the Allan College.

Childbirth education focus of 20th meet

More than 40 nationally and internationally recognized experts on family centered maternity care, infant care and parenting will be featured at the 1980 International Childbirth Education Association convention.

The meeting is slated for June 27 to July 1 at the Detroit Plaza Hotel. It will culminate months of planning by many local volunteers such as Melodee Lewin of Southfield.

"Because ICEA is celebrating its 20th convention year, we wanted to make sure that this convention, the first to come to Detroit is the best ever," Mrs. Lewin said. She is a member of a Plymouth Childbirth Education Association.

Key speakers include Helen Caldwell, M.D., an Australian-born anti-nuclear activist who will discuss the effects of radiation on the fetus.

Melvin Stratmeyer, Ph.D., of the U.S. Food and Drug Administration will speak about the biological effects of ultrasound on human development.

Other convention speaker are E.F. Lenoski, M.D., who will discuss "Freedom of Choice: Developing Parent Potential," and John H. Kennell, M.D., co-author of "Maternal Infant Bonding."

IN ADDITION to ICEA, the con-

vention is sponsored by Childbirth Information Service, Plymouth Childbirth Education Association, ICEA Inc. of Windsor, Childbirth Preparation Association, Lamaze Childbirth Association and others.

Last year, these and other area ICEA member groups trained more than 15,000 expectant couples in the area.

Local volunteers in addition to Mrs. Lewin are Gail Watson, Lillian Adler, Lori Steinlauf and Debbie Akers, all of Southfield.

Four general sessions are planned as well as 60 concurrent meetings. Some 1,000 delegates are expected.

Sessions will cover topics such as drug use during pregnancy, fetal alcohol syndrome, preparing fathers for childbirth and infant auto safety.

Also featured will be an exhibits area and a tour of some communities, clinics and food houses which have benefited from FocusHope.

A TEACHER enrichment program on June 27-28 will precede the actual convention. It will offer in-depth workshops designed to increase the knowledge and skills of childbirth educators.
