TROY

SYLVAN GLEN

Sylvan Glen is at 19 Mile and Rochester Road. An 18-hole course, it measures 6,177 yards from the back tees, 5,657 from the front. Par for the course is 70.

The longest hole at Sylvan Glen is the 453-yard, par-5 fifth hole. The seventh hole, however, is considered the most difficult. A long par 3 at 210 yards from the back tees, 176 from the front, the seventh hole features a creek guarding a narrow approach to the green. The green is also heavily trapped.

Electric and pull carts are available for rent from the pro shop.

Fees at Sylvan Glen are, on weekdays, \$4.50 for nine holes and \$6.50 for 18 holes for residents, and \$5 for nine

holes and \$7.50 for 18 holes for non-residents. Weekend rates are \$5.25 for nine holes and \$8 for 18 holes for residents, and \$6.50 for nine holes and \$7.50 for 18 holes for non-residents.

There are leagues in play Monday through Thursday. Nine holes are always kept open for public use during the morning leagues. The course is closed to the public 3:30-6 p.m. Monday through Thursday for league play.

Sylvan Glen opens at 7 a.m. on weekdays, 6:30 a.m. on the weekend. The course closes at dusk.

OAKLAND COUNTY PARKS AND RECREATION

RED OAKS

Red Oaks is a nine-hole course operated by the Oakland County Parks and Recreation Commission at 29600 John R in Madison Heights. Total yardage for the course is 2,365. Par is 31.

The third hole, a 140-yard par 3, is considered the most difficult. A pond in front of the tee presents a hazard that

many golfers fail to clear.

Both electric and pull carts are available at Red Oaks, as they are at all Oakland County Parks and Recreation golf courses. Facilities include a pro-shop and a driving range.

Fees at Red Oaks are \$3.25 for Oakland County residents, \$2.50 for non-residents on weekdays. Weekend and holiday fees are \$4 for residents, \$4.25 for non-residents. Resident juniors 17 and under may golf for \$1.50 before 4 p.m. weekdays. Resident seniors are charged \$2 and non-resident seniors are charged \$2.25 before 4 p.m.

Leagues are 3:30-6:30 p.m. Monday, 8:30-11 a.m. Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday; and 4-6:30 p.m. Friday.

Red Oaks opens at 6:30 a.m. and closes at dusk. Call 541-5030 for more information.

WHITE LAKE OAKS

White Lake Oaks is at 991 Williams Lake Road in Pontiac. An 18-hole course, White Lake Oaks measures 5,616 yards from the back tees, 5,446 from the front. Par is 70 from the back tees, 74 from the front.

The par-4 13th hole is considered the toughest at White Lake Oaks. A dogleg to the right, the right side of the fairway is also guarded by a pond.

Resident fees at White Lake Oaks, as at all other Oakland County Parks and Recreation Commission 18-hole courses, are \$4 for nine holes and \$6.50 for 18 holes during the week, and \$5 for nine holes and \$8 for 18 holes on weekends and holidays. Non-resident fees are \$4.50 for nine and \$7 for 18 during the week, and \$5.50 for nine and \$8.50 for 18 on weekends and holidays.

In addition, resident juniors under 17 and senior citizens may golf at discount

rates on weekdays before 4 p.m. Fees for resident juniors and seniors are \$2 for nine holes, \$3.25 for 18. Non-resident seniors may also golf at the same time for the discount price of \$2.25 for nine holes, \$3.75 for 18.

Leagues at White Lake Oaks are 8:30-9 a.m. Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday; and 4-6:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday.

The course opens at 7 a.m. weekdays, 6 a.m. on the weekend. It closes at dusk.

SPRINGFIELD OAKS

Springfield Oaks is at 12450 Andersonville Road in Davisburg. Total yardage for the course is 6,305 from the back tees, 5,695 from the front. Par is 70 from the back tees, 72 from the front.

The par-4, 12th hole is considered the most difficult. The fairway is bordered by a tree-filled gully on the left and by a pond on the right. There is also a trap to the right side of the fairway, and the green is trapped as well.

Afternoon leagues are 4-6 p.m. Morning leagues, during which nine holes are always kept open for the public, are 8-9 a.m. Monday, 8-10:45 a.m. Tuesday, 8-9:35 a.m. Wednesday; and 8-10:45 Friday.

Springfield Oaks opens at 7 a.m. weekdays, 6 a.m. on the weekend. The course closes at dusk.

GLEN OAKS

Glen Oaks is at 3500 13 Mile in Farmington Hills. It measures 6,248 yards from the championship tees, 6,009 from the back tees and 5,666 from the front tees. Par is 70 for both

the championship and back tees, 72 for the front.

A long par-4, the 445-yard 14th hole, is considered the most difficult on the course.

There are 39 leagues that compete at Glen Oaks. Leagues are 7-10:30 a.m. and 4-6:30 p.m. Monday; 8:30-10:30 a.m. Tuesday; and 8:30-9:30 a.m. Wednesday.

There always are nine holes open to the public during the morning leagues.

Troy team gets dumped in tennis league finals

The Motor City Racquet Club got superior play from its men's team to edge Troy Racquet Club, 187-176, for the Metro Tennis League championship.

holds the school individual batting average record (.453 last year) and owns the school career average record of .378. Mitchell batted .318 this year, with 21 RBIs and 21 hits. He made the MSAA all-star team the past two years, and was a second-team All-State player. He had seven extra-base hits, including three home runs.

RICH NUTTER (North Farmington, senior): Nutter, a third baseman, batted .407 and led the team in RBIs. A team captain, Nutter stole 11 bases (11 at-tempts) and was selected to the NSL's first-team this year. He was 5-0 as a pitcher with a 0.53 earned-run average. "Rich has an excellent arm, fine speed and lots of savvy," said Maxwell. Nutter was a three-year member of the Raiders baseball team.

MATT RUUD (North Farmington, junior): A lefthander, Ruud pitched 12 games this season and allowed only three earned runs (0.53 ERA). A first-team all-league selection, Ruud struck out 83 batters in 59 1/3 innings pitched, walked 18 and had three saves. "Matt has excellent control and can throw smoke. He should continue to improve," said Maxwell. "He has good breaking stuff and is easily coachable."

KEN SULLIVAN (Southfield, senior): Southfield's "Next Valuable Player." Sullivan batted .433 with 29 hits and 15 RBIs. Sullivan, an outfielder, had eight doubles and one triple. The 6-1, 190-pound Sullivan made the All-SMA team and was a second-team All-Region selection. Sullivan was the most dependable Blue Jay, according to coach Chris Dubowski.

PETE TOMPSON (Farmington Hills, senior): An infielder, Tompson batted .352 with four home runs and a school-record 27 RBIs. He was used as a pitcher late in the season, compiling

a 2-0 record (both wins in state competition) and a 0.98 ERA. Tompson, who made only five errors in 28 games, had a "riffle" arm and was one of the team's top power hitters.

RICK ZIEGLER (Birmingham Seaholm, junior): A 6-2 pitcher, Ziegler had a 4-1 record with a 1.10 ERA. His only loss was to Kimball even though he hurled a two-hitter. A lefthander, Ziegler's season was cut short by mononucleosis.

JERRY MAXWELL (North Farmington, coach): Maxwell's Raiders had a fine 15-5 record this season, and won a district championship. He was voted the "Coach-of-the-Year" in Region 12 and by the coaches in the O&E area. Under Maxwell, the Raiders have won three league titles (1977, 1978 and 1980), compiling an 81-30 overall record. He has been head coach at North Farmington for the past five years.

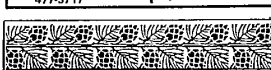
