Plymouth Is Location Of Area Stamp Show

A 200 frame exhibition and bourse will be staged by the West Suburban Stamp Club May 16 and 17 in the Plymouth Senior High School Main at Church Streets.

The show will consist of 150 frames in open competitive exhibition and a 50 frame invitational court of honor featuring outstanding collections from midwestern collectors with a 20 dealer bourse.

THEME OF the show is the 35th anniversary of the sailing of the Mayflower from Plymouth, England.

In commemoration of the event the West Suburban Stamp Club will sponsor a set of three commemorative covers in honor of the Mayflower. One cover will commemorate the sailing from Plymouth, England on Sept. 16, 1620. The

second will commemorate the signing of the Mayflower Compact on Nov. 11, 1620 and the third will honor the landing at Plymouth Mass. on Nov. 21, 1620.

The covers will be canceled with the show cancellation on May 16 and 17. Price of the three covers is \$1 and collectors should specify which day's cancellation is desired. If no specific request is made the May 16 cancellation will be applied.

Both days covers may be obtained for \$2. Collectors desiring three sets of each day may purchase them for \$5. Orders should be accompanied by a self-addressed stamped business size envelope for each three covers ordered as all covers will be unaddressed and sent to collectors under separate cover.

Postage in the amount of six cents for each three covers should be applied to the return envelope.

The theme of the show applies to the location of Plymouth as an unusual program of friendly relations has been developed between Plymouth, England and the local area.

In 1957, when Plymouth, Mich. celebrated its 10th anniversary, the city of Plymouth, England, sent a "Plymouth Rock" which is now displayed in the wall between the City Hall and the library. The Lord Mayor of Plymouth, England, visited Plymouth in November 1968 and presented a cobblerstone from the Mayflower dock to Mayor James McKeon.
