The funds are revenues from entrance and user fees at federal recreation areas, proceeds from the sale of surplus federal real property, and the federal motorboat fuels tax.

STATES RECEIVE 40% divided equally among the 50 states. Five % is reserved for unforesseen needs. Another 40% is divided among the states, territories and the District of Columbia on the basis of population.

Federal resources and programs get 10% and out-of-state visitor use gets 5%.
The apportionment to the states and territories exceed those of the previous year by \$16 million.


