PERHAPS THE most subtle, yet pervasive, cause of crime is the growing disrespect expressed by many, for the moral authority of the law.

To work effectively, law needs law-abiding citizens. There cannot be enough policemen anywhere to prevent crime. Law survives because law enforcement is needed only against a few. When it is needed against many, as in white-collar crime, tax evasions, and such violations as drug addiction, law enforcement breaks down.

Thus, the control of crime requires: a) improving the quality of life for the most deprived among use by reforming the criminal justice system; c) establishing clear and effective forms of deterrents for would-be criminals; and of restoring those moral values which are the foundation of a law-abiding society.
