Tennis players have had several months to fine-tune their games this summer. Time is quickly approaching to test their skills against others under competitive circumstances.

Westland, Livonia and Garden City have all announced dates for their annual open tournaments. Any amateur may compete in any of the tournaments. There are no residency requirements.

WESTLAND OPEN TOURNAMENT

Sponsored by the parks and recreation department, Westland's tournament will be conducted Aug. 7-10 at the Multi-Purpose Arena.

Entry forms may be picked up at the arena office, 6210 Wildwood (east of Wayne Road between Cherry Hill and Ford).

Registration fees may be paid there or mailed to the parks and recreation department, 36551 Ford Road, Westland 48185. Registration deadline is 5 p.m. Monday.

Entry fee for adult singles is \$3, junior singles \$2, adult doubles and mixed doubles \$5, and junior doubles and mixed doubles \$4.

Divisions include junior boys 14 years of age and younger, junior boys

18 and under, junior girls 18 and under, and adults.

There must be at least four entries in a classification before the event will be conducted.

Players may compete in one singles event and one doubles event. Each player must supply all of his own equipment including a new can of U.S.T.A. approved tennis balls.

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Hills '9' slips in Legion race

The Bloomfield Legion baseball team slid into second place in District 18 competition, despite winning two of three games over the weekend.

Bloomfield lost to Berkley 14-1 on Friday, then swept a Sunday double-header from Troy Clawson, 10-5 and 7-0.

Bloomfield has a 17-4 record going into the last week of the regular season, one game behind league-leading Royal Oak at 18-5. Bloomfield and Royal Oak meet Sunday in a double-header starting at 1 p.m. at Memorial Park in the last series of the season.

Bloomfield plays Friday at Fern-

dale. Bloomfield got plenty of pitching on Sunday — something the team was lacking during its recent three-game skid. Mike Rom pitched a two-hitter in the first game, and Paul Sabol pitched a one-hitter in the second.

Rom struck out seven, walked six

and allowed one run. Paul Drieman accounted for four of Bloomfield's 12 hits. Drieman was 4-for-4, all doubles.

Eric Girdler was 2-for-4 with 2 RBIs. Mike Kaline was 2-for-3 with one RBI. Dave Mitchell was 2-for-4. Rick Hawkins had two RBIs.

Sabol struck out 11 in the second game. He walked none and faced 22 batters, one over the minimum of 21 for a seven-inning game.

Bloomfield supported Sabol with 10 hits. Hawkins led the attack with two doubles and a single in four at bats. Girdler and Tony Bruce drove in two runs each. George Anast and Bill Elbert doubled, and Andy Sugarman tripled.

Friday's game was the culmination of a three-game skid during which Bloomfield fell out of first place in District 18. Eric Girdler lost his first game of the season, working three and a third innings before he was relieved by Dave Dyrus.

Local sailor tastes the salt

wind so you get the maximum amount of speed potential out of the sail.

"The mental aspect is the most difficult part," Douglas continued, "knowing when to change things. And you also have to work in conjunction with another sail trimmer — the mainsail trimmer — the two of you have to work together so your sails work together, rather than the two of you being obstinate and doing whatever you want."

"Your sails may look nice, but if they're not working together, then it's usually slow."

Perhaps the most visible position, both on a boat racing a closed course and on one racing long distance, is the skipper.

"It's difficult to say if he's more important," said Douglas. "He's the guy who's known as the winning or losing person."

"He steers the boat," he continued,

"and he can make it go fast or slow according to how he steers the boat. You can have excellent sail trimmers and crew, but if he steers the boat all over, they're going to be slow."

TED TURNER is an example of a successful skipper, according to Douglas.

"He's a fine sailor," said Douglas, "an excellent sailor, one of the best. He'll scream at you one minute, then praise you the next."

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
