The complaint marks the first time all five major domestic automobile manufacturers — AMC, GM, Ford, Chrysler and Volkswagen of America — have joined in an action against EPA. The lawsuit filed in Detroit's Federal District Court charges Costle failed in his duty to promulgate two supporting regulations, covering the

in his duty to promulgate two supporting regulations, covering the certification of aftermarket emissions control parts and the specification of proper maintenance for vehicles, prior to the time the performance warranty takes effect.

THE WESTERN Wayne Oakland County Board of Realtors supports the Tisch amendment as the "only tax measure presently proposed for the November ballot capable of bringing real relief to property owners," according to board president John J. 


