## Ku Klux Klan requests permit for rally in park

A local chapter of the Knights of the
Ku Klux Klan has filled a request to
hold an Aug. 23 rally from 1-3 p.m. at
the city-owned Ford Field recreation
area at Farmington and Lyndon roads.
Rocky Subayda, a former city council candidate now associated with the
Klan, said the rally will be in support
of the Tisch tax cut amendment. He
also told The Observer this could be the
first in a series of monthly rallies.
Robert Tisch, the Shiawassee Drain
commissioner sponsoring the tax cut
amendment, denied any connection
with the proposed Klan rally.
Tisch said he's "not very thrilled"
about gaining support "from organizations which I would call hate organizations."

Tisch said he doesn't endorse the KKK support. But added: I daresay I should prohibit them," he added. The Klan rally request is expected to be reviewed by the Livonia City Coun-cil Monday night. City Attorney Harry Tatigian indicated the city would have a difficult time denying the request. Rocky Subayda, 28, a Livonia City Council candidate who finished eighth in a field of eight candidates last year, admitted that his rally plans were par-tially motivated by political considera-tions.

He said local Klan numbers have urged him to begin his political campaigning early.


