

# Stratford stars in package tour

Reservations are still being accepted for one of two trips to the Stratford Theatre Festival in Stratford, Ont., sponsored by the Community House.

Participants will see "The Beggar's Opera" by John Gay the evening of Aug. 9 and "Henry V" by William Shakespeare on the afternoon of Aug. 10.

"The Beggar's Opera" is an 18th century ballad opera that was revolutionary in its day. It characters are all drawn from the underworld of English society, and its melodies are borrowed from folk tunes and airs which could be heard throughout the streets of London.

The Stratford Youth Choir is an added feature to the production.

"Henry V" is Shakespeare's portrait of the monarch as a young man. Scenes of the young king among ordinary soldiers of the field alternate with a portrait of the French court.

THE COMMUNITY HOUSE group will leave by chartered, air-conditioned bus. The Victorian Inn will host the group while in Stratford.

Dinner preceding the performance has been planned for the evening of Aug. 9 at the new Terrace Restaurant overlooking the Avon. A Sunday matinee performance, has been planned at the Church Restaurant.

The Community House Stratford Festival entertainment package includes round-trip transportation from Birmingham, hotel accommodations at The Victorian Inn in Stratford, dinner at the Terrace Restaurant, brunch at the Church Restaurant, box lunch enroute home, all tips and gratuities and reserved seats for both theater performances. 



When a tornado threatens, listen to WOMC FM104 for exclusive, accurate weather reports and follow these basic safety rules:

- Stay away from windows, doors and outside walls. Protect your head.
- In homes and small buildings, go to the basement or to an interior part on the lowest level. Get under something sturdy.

- In schools, factories, shopping centers or other public places, move to pre-designated shelter areas. Interior hallways on lowest floors are best.
  - In mobile homes or vehicles, leave them and go to more substantial shelter.
  - If outdoors, and no shelter is nearby, lie flat in the nearest ditch or ravine and shield head with arms.
- Tornado Watch: Tornadoes and severe thunderstorms are possible.
- Tornado Warning: Tornado detected. Take shelter immediately.
