Fifty-five antique dealers will display their wares at the 33rd annual antique market and sale sponsored by the Junior Group of the League for the Handicapped-Goodwill.

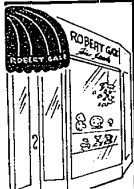
To be held Nov. 8, 9 and 10, the show will take place in the Fairlane Manor in Dearborn.

Volcanic ash poses a threat to lungs

The specter of possible damage to human lungs has been raised by the volcanic eruptions from Mount St. Helens this year.

The volcanic ash was rich in a substance called silica which is contained in rocks, stones, and ores in the earth's crusts. When silica is blasted or drilled, the resulting dust contains free, or uncombined silicon dioxide.

Inhaling dust filled with this white or colorless compound can cause a disease called silicosis which scars and stiffens the tissue of the lungs. As of now, there is no known way to reverse the damage inflicted.

Scientists suspect that the disease of silicosis has existed for thousands of years, probably as long as man has made tools out of flint and inhaled the dust.

Today, one million workers are exposed to silica dust in various occupations; the U. S. Department of Labor estimates that nearly 60,000 of them have silicosis.

According to the American Lung Association, susceptibility to diseases caused by inhaling mineral dusts, including dusts with silicon dioxide, varies widely from person to person. Without exception, occupational dusts induce disease more rapidly and more frequently in smokers than in nonsmokers, say the Christmas Seal people.

Cigarette smoking also hastens the progression of lung disease. General air pollution aggravates the damaging effects, but to a smaller degree.

This year the American Lung Association is funding a research study to investigate exactly how scarring of the lungs develops from inhaling toxic substances and what might be done to avert the damage.

The CanSurmount Visitation Program is designed for persons who are unable to attend community self-help groups, but who have the need to talk with other cancer patients.

ACS volunteers, themselves patients or family members, have been trained by health care professionals to provide psycho-social support through personal and phone visits.

Originated in Denver in 1976, the CanSurmount concept is a means of alleviating social isolation and helping patients make the necessary adjustments to cope with the disease.
