

Area road racer on right track

Patrick Jacquemart wears a lot of different hats when it comes to working for the Renault road racing team.

The 34-year-old Canton Township resident is a driver, mechanic, engineer and manager.

He became the Renault competition manager three years ago and has made tremendous progress in recent weeks.

On Aug. 3 he drove his modified Le Car to a second straight International Motor Sportscar Association championship at the Portland (Ore.) International Raceway.

His average speed for the 32-lap event, part of the Champion Spark Plug Challenge Series, was 80.84 mph. He won the pole position in the 40-car field with a qualifying record speed of 82.398.

A native Paris, Jacquemart ran second,

sandwiched between two Mazda RX-3's, until the 27th lap when he turned on the burners for a record lap time of 1:23.83, moving into first place to stay.

A week earlier (July 28), Jacquemart won the 75-mile Champion Spark Plug Challenge at Golden State International Raceway near San Francisco. It was his second straight triumph in his front-wheel drive Renault at the scenic and twisting northern California 2.5-mile circuit.

Jacquemart posted a 2.3-second victory at Golden State and broke his own race lap record with an average speed of 78.785 mph to eclipse his old mark of 74.765.

"We've done a lot of work on the car," said Jacquemart, whose shop is based in Belleville. "It's a continuous development to make it faster

and more reliable."

The Champion Spark Plug Challenge includes 14 races from February through November.

Jacquemart and two full-time technicians will now prepare for another Challenge race Aug. 30 at Elkhart Lake, Wis. in quest of a third straight win.

"It's completely different than stock or Indianapolis type racing," explained Jacquemart.

"The road course represents real driving conditions. All the courses are different. The turns are different and the straightaways vary."

"It represents actual situations on the road only it's on a closed circuit."

Jacquemart, through a friend, became involved in racing at the age of 18. He drove Formula Three through the Wisconsin driver's school before moving on to Renault's

promotional single-seater series, better known as Formula Renault.

Other graduates of the Renault system include Formula One Grand Prix racers Jacques Laffite and the late Patrick Depailler, who was killed last week testing an Alfa Romeo car in West Germany.

Jacquemart came to New Jersey in 1973 with a job in Renault's U.S. engineering department. In 1976, still involved with driving, he raced Le Car to 9 of 12 Showroom Stock wins and the Sports Car Club of America (SCCA) Northeast Division Championship.

Since 1978 he has tested and redesigned Le Car for competition. He practices for the Challenge races at Michigan International Speedway (MIS) and Waterford Hills. "We're in it for the pro-

motion of Le Car," he said.

And by driving the car himself, Jacquemart feels he can give the product an added lift.

"Driving is like a disease or passion," he said. "I really enjoy it. Sometimes it's dangerous, but you really don't think about it. If you do, you shouldn't race."

Jacquemart moved to Canton with his wife, Maryvonne, because "I liked the area."

"I wanted to find something not too far from our shop," he said.

The affable Frenchman is looking forward to his next test hoping he can give Le Car an even better name against the likes of BMW, Datsun, Mazda, Buick, Volkswagen, Toyota and Honda.

"We get about 30,000 people out to a race," he said. "It's very exciting competition."
