Rehab center gets Kresge \$\$

A \$400,000 challenge grant has been approved by the trustees of the Kresge Foundation to be used toward the construction of Henry Ford Hospital's new alcoholism rehabilitation center, Maplegrove.

The grant was awarded on conditional basis, pending notification by Feb. 15 of the actual construction costs, assurance that it is within available resources and certification that the hospital has acquired the balance of funds needed to complete the project.

Maplegrove, a 50-bed residential treatment center, is under construction on the 80-acre site of the hospital's ambulatory care center in West Bloomfield Township. Construction is expected to be completed by the end of this year. When Maplegrove opens, it will offer residential and outpatient treatment programs.

Students find jobs on campus

More than 18,000 students at Michigan State University looking for part-time work this past year found it right on campus. And in these tough economic times, just as many are expected to be looking for work this coming school year, said Jack Shingleton, director of MSU's Placement Services.

Shingleton said last year's student payroll amounted to \$14 million from July 1979 through June 1980. "The average number of students employed at any one time is between 6,000 and 8,000," said Shingleton, who oversees all student employment on campus. "Of course the employment drops during the summer months."

Some jobs are seasonal or don't last all year. Sometimes students stop working because of a heavy class load. "We understand that studies come first," he said.

About 2,500 of the students are on work-study grants, a federal program which helps subsidize the students wages as a part of their financial aid package.

According to Shingleton's statistics, student employees work an average of 11 hours a week. With the minimum wage going up this year, students will earn from \$3.38 to \$5.05 an hour. The jobs are classified by the skills required — everything from food service and grounds maintenance to skilled helpers in science laboratories.

Vets advised to check benefit coverage overseas

Veterans planning to live or work in a foreign country should check before leaving the U.S. with the Veterans Administration to find out what benefits are available outside of the country.

Gordon Clowney, director of the VA regional office in Detroit, said veterans with service-connected disabilities should obtain a statement of their disabilities from the office maintaining their medical records, even for a vacation.

The statement will enable the veteran to obtain emergency treatment or hospitalization at VA expense. Proper application for medical benefits and statement must be presented to the U.S. Embassy or consular office in a foreign country. The application should be made within 72 hours of need.

Clowney says the Veterans Memorial hospital in Manila is the only overseas hospital in which VA aid care is available to veterans with non-service-connected disabilities. Admission is on a space available basis and only if the veteran cannot afford other hospitalization.

The VA director reminded veterans that only those who are retired from the military are eligible for treatment at overseas military hospitals and clinics.
