The collection of firefighter memor-

abilia now on display includes lanterns that were carried on fire trucks from 1890-1921; leather-fire belientes, worn from 1880-1930; leather fire buckets, parade helmets and belmets from a English fire brigade, as well as items once used by the Plymouth Fire Department.


