Visitors to the Plymouth Historical Museum are invited to ring an 1850 muffin-tin bell carried by fire warden or patrol. During those years the entire community was alerted by the muffin tin bell alarm that there was a fire.

The collection of firefighter memorabilia now on display includes lanterns that were carried on fire trucks from 1890-1921; leather fire helmets, worn from 1880-1930; leather fire buckets, parade helmets and helmets from an English fire brigade, as well as items once used by the Plymouth Fire Department.

The museum, at 155 S. Main Street, is open Thursdays, Saturdays and Sundays from 1-4 p.m. Admission is \$1 for adults, 50 cents for those from 12-17, and 25 cents for children from 5-11.
