SARIN'S MUSICAL CAREER began when he entered New England Con-servatory of Music in Boston in 1938 at 17. He studied trumpet with Georges Mager and entered Juilliard for gradu-

Sarin left professional playing in 1980 to teach trumpet at the University of Wichita in Kansas. During the three years he was there he developed the Wichita Brass and Percussion Ensem-ble to the point where it was invited to

play at a national convention and made commercial recordings.

SARIN ACCEPTED an offer to be first trumpet with the Israel Philharmonic Orchestra in 1933, stayed one year and decided to return to teaching. He has since taught in the public schools in Michigan and has taught and lectured at Michigan State University and Delta College. He and his wife, a planist, both have private students.

The new wind ensemble, he said, will give talented young musicians an opportunity to develop their skills far beyond what is possible in a school music organization. He sees the level of performance as high and the approach sophisticated.

Sarin said he is delighted with the response he has received in Southfield from cultural director, Marilow Belanger, and the people who are working to promote the idea.

"I consider Southfield," he said, "to be the most progressive community in the tri-county area. Southfield has a total commitment to the arts and there's nothing like this in other cities."
