

# YMCA sets fall slate

The Farmington area YMCA has a fall lineup that offers more than 140 classes for all age groups.

They range from a swimming class for infants to a Highland bagpipes class.

There's swimming classes for adults without swimming experience and adult exercise classes in the pool, gymnastics. Both preschool and youths also will be taught as part of the YMCA progressive swim program.

Diving, lifesaving and handicapped swimming will be part of the fall program.

In the area of fitness, a new class, "Body Toning with Small Weights," will be taught on Tuesday and Thursday mornings. Healthy back, slim living, yoga and stress management will be offered as they have in the past, along with almost 20 fitness classes. Dance Fit will be offered five days a week.

There will be several new offerings in the preschool area. A class called "Crispy Critters" is designed especially for the development of 4-year-olds. It meets from 12:30 to 3 p.m. Monday, Wednesday and Friday. It includes circle games, arts and crafts, gym and swim time, plus a daily snack.

**SPECIAL INTEREST** classes have broadened this fall. They include inner beauty which will cover wardrobe, poise, exercise, skin care, hair care, makeup and nutrition. Chess class, Highland bagpipes and Lamaze birth classes are all new this fall.

The "Y" offers basic dance movement, ballroom dance, preschool ballet, belly dance and square dance.

Another expanded area is the YMCA gymnastics. Tumble bugs (ages 3 to 5), Gym bugs (6-7 years), beginners (8 and up), intermediate, and advanced gymnastics will be taught this fall.

The YMCA gymnastic team, which meets five days a week, is open to girls 8 years and older. Coach Kim Sandes can be reached at the "Y" for details.

Class registration is Saturday from 2 p.m. to 4 p.m. for Y-members and Sunday from 2 p.m. to 4 p.m. for members and non-members.
