Anderson wins golf title

Mary Jane Anderson won the championship flight of the recent Forest Lake Country Club Women's Championship.

The championship flight required three days of competition with winners in the first, second, third and fourth flights were decided in two days.

Anderson won the championship with a 254, nine strokes better than her nearest threat, Ingrid Mozar who was runner-up with a 263. Marlene Zdrzal was the low net with a 273.

Betty Schweppe was far and away the winner in first flight with a 191. Ann Wilkins with a 202 was runner-up, and Grace Bond was low net with a 204.

Second flight winners were Trudy Sanford, who shot 204 for first place, Veronica Beidelman, runner-up with a 205, and Annabelle Henley, low net with a 212.

Jane McKinzie shot 221 to earn first place in third flight. Olga Anderson finished close behind with a 223 for the runner-up spot while Ruth Wakeland took low net with a 227.

Marge Haberman tallied a 219 to win in fourth flight. Runner-up Ruth Fugett shot 240 while Doris Dekker's 241 was good for low net.

Racers still keep riding

Local bicycle motocross racers will have a chance to attract some state and national attention Sept. 6 at the Waterford Oaks County Park track.

The track will host an American Bike Association-sanctioned state qualifying race. Winners in their respective age classes will proceed to the state championship to be held Sept. 21 in Woodhaven.

Winners will also receive something more than the trophies normally awarded by Waterford Oaks at each Saturday's races.

"It means that the riders will be able to earn ABA points," said Steve Wofford, Oakland County Parks and Recreation bicycle motocross supervisor, "and they really follow that. It's sort of an honor to accumulate their ABA points."

Wofford said the top racers have their names and point totals listed in "ABA Action" magazine. That national attention should help attract between 400 and 500 entries from all over Michigan for the Sept. 6 race, according to Wofford.

Waterford Oaks usually attracts an average of 150 riders. A record was set Aug. 9 when 225 riders competed.

Waterford Oaks is on Scott Lake Road between Dixie Highway and Watkins Lake Road. For more information, call 858-0915.

Classes hit the trails

Experts on all aspects of park development will participate in a trails planning workshop Sept. 9 at Independence Oaks County Park.

Independence Oaks is at 9501 Sashabaw near Clarkston.

The workshop, developed by the Michigan Recreation and Parks Association Parks and Recreation Committee in conjunction with the Oakland County Parks and Recreation Commission, is open to the public. There is a \$6 fee that includes reference materials and a box lunch.

The seminar will be from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Morning sessions include panel discussions on trail design, construction, signage, layout and maintenance, and a slide presentation on the evolution of Independence Oaks.

Afternoon sessions will include a guided tour of some of the park's eight miles of trails, discussions on the evolution of trails at Independence Oaks, interpretive trails, sensory trails and trails for the handicapped, cross country ski trails, and the design, construction and use of hard surface trails.
