# Manufacturer will replace OU's falling panels

A Toledo glass manufacturer announced Tuesday it will replace all of the 494 reflective glass panes in Oakland University's new \$8.5 million all-glass classroom building at ne cost to the state of Michigan or the university.

More than \$60 of the panes have shattered, buckled and fallen since last March from Jan and Don O'Dowd Hall. The 4-by-6-foot panes cost about \$1,200 each to manufacture and install.

"Due to the continued high incidence of breakage of spandred glass in the original order manufactured for this project, Libby-Owens-Ford, the supplier of the glass, is remanufacturing the entire original order and arranging for replacement in the building at ne expense to the state of Michigan or the university," said James Outhout, autorney for Libby-Owens, in a prepared statement.

O'Dowd Hall is owned by the State Bonding Authority and will be leased by Oakland University.

'We're delighted this thing is not going to end up in a court case,' said James Llewellyn, OU's news director. The university, he said, had to reschedule 10 fall semester classes into other buildings because the panes continued to break.

Oathout said he doesn't know what caused the panes to shatter, buckle, then drop out.

He said the problem was a manufacturing fault that has been eliminated. He said he believes it was isolated to the panes manufactured for Oakland University.

Mike Reiser, regional manager of Libby-Owens, couldn't be reached Tuesday for an explanation of the manufacturing problem.

Libby-Owens has until Jan. 26 to replace the 494 panes,

Llewellyn said.

The five-story O'Dowd Hall is named after Donald D. O'Dowd, the university's first and immediate past president, and his wife. O'Dowd is now executive vice-chancellor at the State University


