

Chaldean priest to be ordained bishop

Monsignor George Garmo of Mother of God Chaldean Catholic Church in Southfield has been elected Archbishop of Mossul, Iraq. His Beatitude Paul Sheikho, Patriarch of Baghdad, Iraq, made the announcement.

"I accepted election by our Chaldean Synod with confidence and in obedience to the Holy Father who called me to serve in union with him in this small part of the Catholic Church," said Msgr. Garmo.

"When you love people, you are not worried about problems."

Msgr. Garmo will be ordained to the episcopacy in Mother of God Church on Sept. 14.

Garmo, 58, was ordained in Rome in 1945 after studying at Propaganda Fidei University. He served as rector of the seminary in the Archdiocese of Mossul.

He served the Chaldean Catholic community in

the Detroit area for 18 years.

"IT IS A DISTINCT HONOR for us to learn that Msgr. Garmo has been named Archbishop of Mossul," said John Cardinal Dearden, Archbishop of Detroit.

"The See that is being entrusted to his care is well known to him.

"He became well-acquainted with its clergy while working as a lector," said Dearden.

"Through his leadership, the parish of Mother of God, Southfield, has built an impressive church

to serve its community," he added.

The Chaldean rite is one of 18 rites recognized by the Vatican.

A rite refers to a tradition of liturgy identifiable by language and practice.

The various rites, including the Chaldean, are in union with the Holy See and are an element of the Catholic Church.

THE CHALDEAN RITE traces its origins to the early Christians of Persia and eastern Syria. The language used in the Chaldean rite is Aramaic or Syro-Chaldaic.
