

# Mediation fails

## SC seeks injunction over strikers

Schoolcraft College has asked Wayne County Circuit Court Judge Michael L. Stacey to order more than 300 striking teachers back to work.

Stacey Friday scheduled a hearing on the request for 9:15 a.m. today in his courtroom, 1501 City-County Building, downtown.

Faculty Forum representatives walked out of a meeting Thursday with college officials and a state-appointed mediator after being advised that the college would seek a return-to-work injunction, allowed by the state public employees relations act.

Public employees strikes are technically illegal under state law, although the law has not prevented teachers and many other public employees from striking in recent years. Employer-sought injunctions are common in teacher and other public employee strikes.

THE COLLEGE Friday filed a complaint with the Michigan Employment Relations Commission (MERC) charging the Faculty Forum, a Michigan Education Association (MEA) affiliate, with "bargaining in bad faith," said college spokesman David Heineman.

Schoolcraft officials also cancelled all scheduled classes Thursday until further notice. The strike, by 160 full-time and about 200 part-time instructors, began Tuesday.

The teachers are seeking a two-year contract with raises of between 9 and 10 percent each year for full-time instructors. Prior to the strike, the college's latest offer was 8 percent in the first year and 7.25 percent in the second.

According to Delavan W. Sipes, Faculty Forum President, there was "no movement" at Thursday's meeting with the MERC-appointed mediator.

"They're taking a hard-line position and so have we," said Sipes.

THE FACULTY'S negotiating committee walked out of the Thursday meeting, assuming the college had already been to court seeking the injunction.

However, the college's attorney, Gregory Muzingo, said the faculty was "advised as a matter of courtesy" that the injunction would be sought either Thursday afternoon or Friday. Sipes said the faculty understood the college had already been to court while the mediation meeting was still in progress.

Muzingo said Faculty Forum representatives have to "show cause" today before Judge Stacey why an injunction should not be issued ordering them back to work.

Schoolcraft officials, he said, have to show that a continued strike would cause "irreparable harm" to students and the college.

The strike is the second faculty walk-out in two years and the third in Schoolcraft's history. The 1978 strike lasted eight school days.

Other unresolved issues include continuation of fully paid medical benefits and salary increases for part-time instructors, who comprise the majority of the faculty.

The college has said it cannot provide a larger than 7.25 percent increase in the second year for full-time faculty without taking the money from proposed part-time faculty increases.
