

Saturday Matinees Returning

Four Saturday afternoon movie matinee programs designed especially for children between the ages of five and 10 will be shown in two area theaters during March, April, May and June.

The program is co-sponsored in the metropolitan area by the Children's Movie of the Month organization and the J.L. Hudson Co.

Local theaters participating in the program are the Terrace Theatre of Livonia and the Quo Vadis in Westland.

TICKETS FOR the entire series go on sale Feb. 9 at the Hudson Ticket Service at all stores. Mail and phone orders will also be taken for the tickets. Cost of the series tickets is \$2.50 for both children and adults. A total of 25,000 seats is available.

Other theaters showing the films include: Adams, downtown Detroit; Eastland at the Eastland Center; Gateway in Sterling Heights; Village in Troy; Wyandotte-Main in

Wyandotte; and the Mt. Clemens Jewel in Mt. Clemens.

The films which will be shown are:

"The Boy and the Laughing Dog," starring Walter Brennan, Phil Harris, Brandon deWilde, Sidney Poitier, William Hopper and Louise Weaver on Saturday, March 21.

One of the few Shirley Temple films in technicolor, "The Blue Bird," will be shown on Saturday, April 18. The film also stars Spring Byington and Nigel Bruce.

On May 16, "Smiley" starring Sir Ralph Richardson, John McCallum, "Chips" Rafferty and Colin Peterson will be shown.

An animated film, "Gay Purr-ee," featuring the voices of Judy Garland, Robert Goulet, Red Buttons, Hermione Gingold and Paul Frees, is the June 13 feature.

ALL THE FILMS will be shown at both 1 and 3 p.m. in all the theaters.

President, said that all the films have received general or G ratings from the Motion Picture Association of America and that the National Catholic Office for Motion Pictures has approved all films as suitable for children between the ages of five and 10.
