LOCKE GROUPED the problem of today's youth rebellion with the problems of poverty, pollution, war and drugs, saying "The problems we face, not only with our youth, but on 12 other fronts, are so great that if we don't begin to work on them, these problems will be irreversible. If we don't find the answer within the next five to six years it will be too late. "There has been accumulating residue that the problems will be too late."
