C'ville Gymnasts Turn Eyes To Taylor

With eyes focused on the return meeting with Taylor Kennedy on Feb. 11 at home, Clarenceville High's gymnasts rallied to a 103-54 victory over Alpena.

Coach Chuck Thompson has stamped Taylor Kennedy, North Farmington and Clarenceville as the top contenders for the state championship now held by their team.

That's why a late season win over Kennedy is so important. It will point out that C'ville

has improved since the earlier loss and thus strengthen hopes for another state crown.

It was the eighth victory against one loss for the Trojans—that loss came at the hands of Kennedy earlier in the year in Taylor by a matter of four points.

C'ville swept firsts in all eight events against Alpena with Rob Struk registering a double with triumphs in floor exercise and tumbling and Bill
