The Progressive Blues Band recently released a 45 rpm record on the Big H label. Side A is "Tiger's Blues," and the flip side is "The Break of Day."

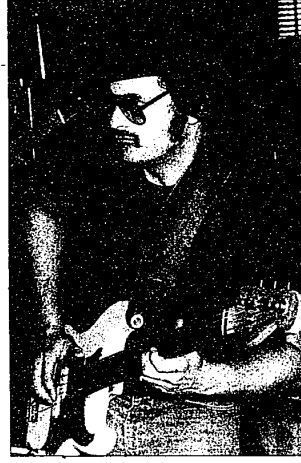
The Detroit Blues Band has a 45 rpm record coming out on the Get Down Records label. The songs are "It Should of Been Me" and "Friday the 13th."
