

In TV movie

West Bloomfield gets supporting role

Word's out that a portion of the CBS movie-of-the-week "Word of Honor" will be filmed at a cottage on West Bloomfield's Pleasant Lake Friday and Saturday.

"We're doing a couple of days in West Bloomfield," reports Evelyn Orbach, location manager for Georgian Bay Productions project.

An undisclosed, but "mutually acceptable" location fee has been arranged with the homeowner, whose name was not announced.

Alex Karras, who heads Georgian Bay, and Mrs. Orbach contacted the West Bloomfield Police Monday to let them know the time, date and location of the filming.

West Bloomfield Police Sgt. Bob Scott said the police will be in the Pleasant Lake area during filming because "there may be a traffic problem."

"We always keep the police apprised," Mrs. Orbach said. "They were very congenial and amenable. We're filming in five townships and every place we're working has just been wonderful."

Mrs. Orbach's remarks reflect on earlier concerns voiced by the Birmingham City Commission which earlier turned down requests from Karras to film the movie in that city.

AS A RESULT, major scenes in the production will be Plymouth's City Hall, not Birmingham's, and Plymouth's Kellogg Park, not Shain Park. Shooting starts in Kellogg Park Sept. 20, reports Mrs. Orbach. Other scenes will be in Pontiac and Royal Oak. The shooting schedule for the motion picture, which stars Karl Malden, will run Sept. 19 through Oct. 3.

The movie is about an investigative reporter on a small town newspaper who becomes involved in a First Amendment freedom of the press battle while writing about the murder of a teenager.

Reasons Birmingham commissioners gave for their turn down included fears that it might recall memories of past murders in the city which could be bad for the city's image. Two commissioners indicated they objected to sex and violence in the script.
