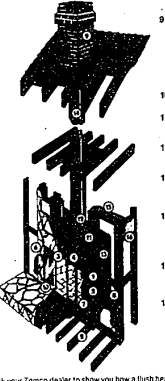


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- A contemporary round termination cap, architectural termination or traditional simulated brick chimney housing completes the entire installation.
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OU soccer squad sports 4-1 record

The number one ranking in the Midwest Soccer Regional could be at stake when Oakland University travels to Green Bay, Wis., to challenge the University of Wisconsin-Green Bay at 1 p.m. Saturday, in the opening round of the Great Lakes Soccer Tournament.

In the other first-round matchup, St. Norbert's College will challenge the University of Illinois Chicago Circle at 3 p.m. Saturday. The championship game is slated for 1 p.m. Sunday, with the consolation game immediately afterwards.

The OU booters have a four-game winning streak at stake after a season-opening loss to Cleveland State University. Junior goalie Mark Hamilton (Rochester High School), a transfer from Macomb Community College, has given the Pioneers solid goalkeeping. He's recorded three shutouts in five games.

While Hamilton is preventing goals, another newcomer is scoring at a record pace. Freshman Morris Lupene (Welland, Ont.) has already outscored last year's leading overall scorer — Dandy Oskey.

Last year Oskey led the team in scoring with nine points in 18 games. This year Lupene has mustered seven goals and four assists. The 5-foot-9, 170-pound forward also leads the team with 25 shots.

Senior Joe Wilden (Utica Eisenhower) follows Lupene in scoring with four points, while Karin Hamrou (Birmingham Groves), freshman Dan Fitzgerald (Granite City, Ill.) and sophomore Dave Morgan (St. Louis, Mo.) have three points each.

The Oakland University women's tennis team will open the 1980 season hosting Oakland Community College 3 p.m. today. Second-year coach Brad Newman's team will host Saginaw Valley College at 3 p.m. tomorrow.

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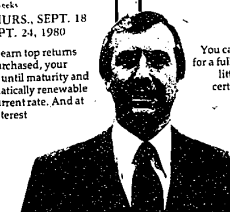
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CITY OF FARMINGTON HILLS
SUMMARY OF PROCEEDINGS
CITY COUNCIL MEETING
SEPTEMBER 15, 1980

The City Council of the City of Farmington Hills held a special meeting September 15, 1980. Mayor Soronen opened the meeting at 7:30 o'clock P.M. Members present were: Burwell, Lange, Oppert, Soronen, Wolf, Alkateeb and Dolan. Others present were City Manager Savage, City Clerk Cairns and City Attorney Donohue.

Council introduced C82-226 amending the Zoning Map from RA-3 to OS-2 for lots 75 and 76 of Farmington Acres Subdivision in the SE 1/4 of Section 33.

Amendatory Zoning Ordinance C82-227 - request to rezone from RA-1 to OS-3 lots 40 and 41 of Supervisor's Plat of Woodcreek Farms in the NE 1/4 of Section 12, was adjourned with a request for opinion from City Attorney.

C82-228 Amendatory Zoning Ordinance was introduced to rezone from RA-1 and RA-3 to RP-2 parcels 23-32-200-008 and 009 on the south side of Nine Mile Road between Gill Road and Green Hill Road.

Amendatory Zoning Ordinance C82-229 to rezone from RA-3 to RP-2 part of parcels 23-33-101-001 and 002, and 23-33-101-003 located on the south side of Nine Mile Road between Drake and Gill Roads was introduced.

Approval was given off-site easement for sewer to serve the Old Homestead Subdivision, subject to approval by City Attorney.

Council referred zoning request No. 8-6-79 to the Planning Commission for further study (Twelve Mile & Halsted), proponent to pay all cost.

Meeting adjourned.
