## Woman awarded flight rating

A Civil Air Patrol (CAP) pilot from Farmington Hills has been awarded IFR rating (Instrument Flight Rules) by the Federal Aviation Administration.

CAP 1st Lt. Marie Littler completed the IFR school at Bay Air Services, Albert Whitted Airport, St. Petersburg, Fla.  
Her flight curriculum involved learning to control and operate her aircraft solely by reference to the aircraft instruments. The training included precision flying, working with air traffic control on use of magnetic headings with specific altitudes of flight, and instrument approaches to airports.

While earning her IFR rating, Lt. Littler also had the opportunity to fly as observer on a coastal reconnaissance mission with the Florida Pinellas Senior Squadron. The squadron runs a community service "Sun Down Patrol" flight along the coast looking for boaters in distress.

Lt. Littler is a five-year member of CAP and former member of the Farmington Squadron, the local unit of CAP. She is now assigned to the Sixgate Squadron for the Novi, Northville and surrounding areas.

As Sixgate Squadron Aerospace Officer her duties include teaching and explaining about flight to squadron cadets to help them advance in the CAP cadet program.
