

Gallery offers lecture series

A four-part lecture series, "Paper, Process and Prints," will be given by Cantor/Lemberg Gallery on four Sundays beginning Oct. 5.

Feature presentations by local and national experts will be given at 1:30 p.m. in the gallery on Oct. 5, 26, Nov. 16 and Dec. 7.

Nancy Donaldson, paper conservator, Detroit Institute of Arts, will discuss the specific properties of paper, care and conservation.

Arts Koutroulis, artist and chairman of fine arts, Center for Creative Studies, will explain the disciplines of printmaking.

Richard Solomon, president of Pace Editions Inc., will explore the relationship between artist and publisher.

Marilyn Finkel, chairwoman of the humanities department and professor of art history, Oakland Community College, will conclude the series with a program on artists of the modern movement and their impact on prints.

Corinne Lemberg, gallery owner, said this is the first time the gallery has planned such a venture.

"The major thrust of the gallery is works on paper, we also love paintings,

but we don't have enough space to store them.

"We feel that a lot of people come into the gallery not knowing what they're seeing. We want to help people understand what they're looking at and buying."

She said the gallery has a strong commitment to the local area and that was one reason for choosing three local speakers. Ms. Donaldson of the Detroit Institute of Arts, Koutroulis, Center for Creative Studies and Mrs. Finkel, art historian, for the series along with Solomon. The other reason is that all are well-qualified in their fields.

Mrs. Lemberg said that 40-50 people would be an ideal number, for the type of salon atmosphere she envisions, informal conversation and discussion after the formal program and refreshments following. While she imagined the series as appealing to novice collectors, so far most of the reservations have come from veteran collectors. A mixture of the two, she said, would be welcome.

Series tickets are \$25. Reservations are limited, 642-6623.

Program topics are: Oct. 2, Isaiah Berlin, author of "Against the Current"; Oct. 9, Jacques Dussot, author of "The Policing of Families"; Oct. 16, Alexander Solzhenitsyn, "The Oak and the Cal"; and Oct. 30, Henry Fairlie, "The Seven Deadly Sins Today."

Programs run until noon. There is a charge of \$4 for members of the Center for New Thinking and \$5 for non-members.

The Sunday Forum, 2:30-4:30 p.m. will be held at the Somerset Mall Auditorium on the four Sundays in October.

The topics which Wine will discuss are: Oct. 5, "Conservatives and Liberals"; Oct. 12, "Natives and Ethnicity"; Oct. 19, "Work and Pleasure"; and Oct. 26, "Power and Fame."

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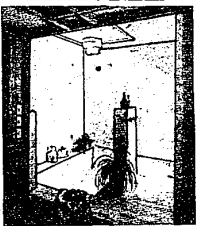
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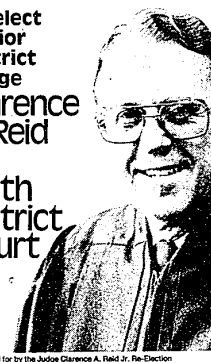
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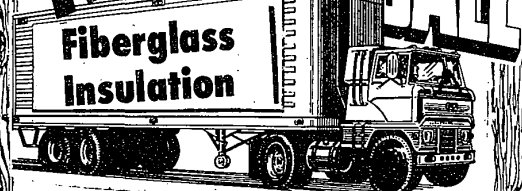
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
