





Clean surface before painting

Did you know that the alumnium siding on your home can be repainted? Many homeowners don't realize that alumnium siding can be repainted just as effectively as any other surface. In fact, most of these factory-finished metal sidings need to be repainted eventually because years of harsh weather causes the finish to become faded or stained. Or, maybe you're just ready for an upbeat, new color scheme. Whatever the reason, here are some tips for a successful job.

Whatever the reason, nere are some upon or successful job. It's vitally important to paint on a clean surface — so scrub off oil, grease, dirt or calking (powdered paint) with a household detergent, warm water and a stiff brush. Remove mildew with a commercial mildew wash available at most paint

stores.
