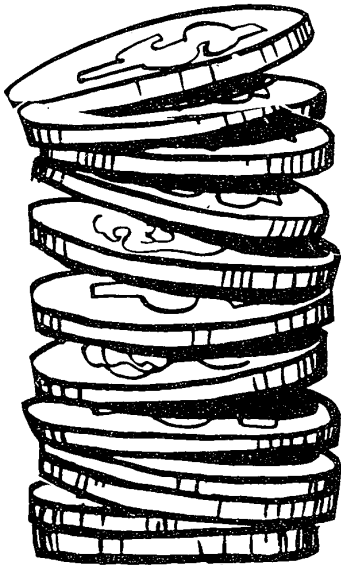
Mesarosch-Becker
