More front-wheel- and four-wheel-drive vehicles are slated for the future, the spokesman added. Renault will buy \$200 million worth of common stock, preferred stock and warrants over the next two years. AMERICAN MOTORS and Renault also have agreed to create a financing subsidiary, American Motors Financial Corporation, to help AMC, Renault and Jeep dealers finance their stocks.

As a result of the deal, "American As a result of the deal, "American Mours will be assured a place among the dozen or so international automotive companies which will survive into the next century," said AMC Chairman Gerald C. Meyers.

"This agreement assures American Motors Gorp, a fine future, in conjunction with Renault, as a dynamic and growing company of worldwide scope," he added.

AMC also is asking for \$200 million in credit under a new bank financing plan that is part of the arrangement.

The package gives Renault three more seats – for a total of live – on AMC \$13-member board of directors. Renault, wowned by the French gov-

cooperate by selling each other's cars and building a car jointly at AMC's Kenusha, Wis, piant. Some 10,000 United Auto Workers union members at two AMC plants in Wisconsin recently ratified a new three-year contract. That agreement helped pave the way for the AMC-Renault agreement, the company said.
