

# Catholic Central to face Rice on Saturday

This is the week that was for Detroit Catholic Central's football team. The Shamrocks will butt heads with archrival Birmingham Brother Rice in a high-school equivalent of USC vs. UCLA, Michigan vs. Ohio State, and Army vs. Navy.

Kickoff is 8 p.m. Saturday at Wisner Stadium in Pontiac. CC won 10-7 last year with a field goal in overtime. Tom Mach, coach of the Shamrocks, said that he has been working on the kicking game in anticipation of another close battle this weekend.

"Three of the four times we've played has been determined on the kicking game," Mach said. "We've been stressing it all week."

Bill Matthews kicks extra points for the Shamrocks. He has been reliable most of the season but did miss two last weekend during CC's 33-0 win over Southgate Aquinas. Matthews also handles the punting chores and has been averaging a little better than 40 yards per punt so far this season.

"We're looking for a very good defensive unit (from Rice)," Mach said. "I don't think they've been scored on yet. They've been very opportunistic this year," Mach continued. "We feel we'll have to stay away from errors on offense."

Actually, Rice has relinquished just one touchdown all season long. Mach said that his troops will likely try to grind it out with a running attack. However, he was quick to add that CC threw 18 passes against Rice last year.

## Notre Dame beats Bishop Borgess

Gary Cook, first-year football coach at Redford Bishop Borgess, was discouraged that his Spartans lost to Harper Woods Notre Dame, 31-14, last weekend, but he did see a silver lining in the cloud.

"The second half was the best football we've played all season long," he said. "We're down, but coming off a positive thing. I'm encouraged, but we have a long way to go."

The positive thing to which Cook referred was the performance of the defensive unit.

"The defense played the best it's played all year in the second half. The defense is coming around. As young as we are, we're improving quite a bit," Cook said.

Inexperience is a great part of the problem, Cook believes. "We're playing three sophomores and five juniors. The defense is improving, but, so far, we haven't put together a whole game," Cook said.

Borgess made a run at the Irish after falling behind 24-0. A fumble and poor

punt led to two Notre Dame touchdowns. Frank Wedesky threw scoring passes of 20 and 12 yards to Bob Smedley to pull the Spartans within striking range 24-14, but that's as close as Borgess came.

The Irish scored their only touchdown of the second half during the last few minutes to make their victory margin 17 points.

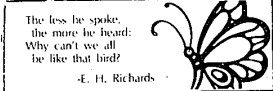
