

Activities surround temple opening

Michigan's two U.S. senators and local township and church officials will be on hand Sunday to climax four days of festivities marking the dedication of Temple Israel's new building at 5725 Walnut Lake Road in West Bloomfield.

The reception from 2-5 p.m. Sunday is open to the community to participate and view the temple's facilities. It's 61,000-square-foot building, designed by Tarapata, MacMahon, Paulsen As-

sociates, was built on 22.5 acres by Etkin, Johnson and Korb.

Sens. Carl Levin and Donald Riegle will speak. Representing the community will be Township Supervisor John Deberry, the Rev. Leonard Chrobot, president of St. Mary's College, Orchard Lake; and the Rev. John Freed, rector of Holy Spirit Lutheran Church.

Jack Schon, president of the Synagogue Council of Greater Detroit, and a

past president of another West Bloomfield Jewish congregation, Beth Abraham-Hillel-Moses, will represent the Jewish community.

THE FIRST DEDICATION event is scheduled today when more than 1,000 temple children are expected to join in a children's dedication service.

A traditional aspect of the service will be participation of the Leslie R. Schimler family in the passing of the Torahs from one generation to the next.

Schimler, immediate past president and now honorary president of Temple Israel, will share the honors with Mrs. Schimler, her mother, Dorothy Schimler, their children and grandchildren.

The formal dedication service is planned for 8:30 p.m. Friday, when Albert Vorspan, vice president of the Union of American Hebrew Congregations, is the principal dedicatory speaker.

Vorspan represents the Reform Jewish movement, made up of 730 temples throughout the United States and Canada.

The rabbis of the congregation, Rabbi M. Robert Syme, Rabbi Harold S. Loss and Rabbi Leon Fram, together with Cantor Harold Orbach, will conduct the worship service.

A dinner-dance is planned as a change of pace from formal dedication events, and will be at 7 p.m. Saturday in the temple's Herman Hall.

The facility is being used for the first time for a congregational event, and it will be dedicated by Rose Herman and her family.

It was Mrs. Herman's gift, in memory of her late husband, John R. Herman, that sparked the beginning of the building project. The \$250,000 gift was the largest single contribution to the temple's building campaign.

THE BUILDING consists of a 1,000 permanent seat sanctuary, atrium, social hall-auditorium, family chapel (still under construction), 12 classrooms, two nursery rooms, a youth room, administrative offices and a combination library-board room.

The building exterior will be landscaped, utilizing various areas for a reflecting pond, sukkah, wedding court and outdoor gardens and plantings.

Permanent parking can accommodate 250 cars, with additional lawn parking for 200 more.

The building was scaled down for acceptance by the West Bloomfield Township Board.

That approval was given more than three years ago after four previous attempts. Following the last denial, temple officials went to court and won their suit to locate on the property.

The membership of Temple Israel consists of 1,750 families, almost 200 of which have joined since the congregation moved from its location on Manderson in Detroit in September.

Deadline nearing for citizen honor

cost \$200 than it is to ask them to pay \$2,000 in hospital fees for a patient suffering from sclerosis of the liver, Brotherton says.

The legislation is so badly needed, Brotherton feels, that the issue of more effective substance abuse treatment is

more important than the mandate.

"The rest of the bill is excellent," he says.

The package will be taken up by the Senate Committee on Health and Social Services on Nov. 19. Brotherton says there is a good chance it will be acted upon before December.


