### Brother Rice stays atop grid ranking

Birmingham Brother Rice's 24-14 victory over Detroit Catholic Central solidifies its hold on the No. 1 spot in the Observer & Eccentric football rankings in Oakland County.

There are no changes in this week's poll. North Farmington remains the No. 2 team, although No. 3 Farmington Harrison gained some ground on its arch-rival.

Birmingham Groves stays No. 4, Auburn Hills Avondale is No. 5, Bloomfield Hills Andover is No. 6 and Troy Athens is No. 7.

The big game of week pits No. 4 Groves against No. 7 Athens. Both squads are once-beaten, and the winner is likely to take home the Metro Suburban Activities Association trophy. The Falcons edged Rochester Adams, 7-0, and Athens got past previously-ranked Bloomfield Hills Lahser, 21-14, last week.

NORTH FARMINGTON defeated hapless Redford Thurston, 47-14. Harrison mauled Waterford Moit, 35-0. The Hawks and the Raiders meet on the eighth week of the season.

Avondale continues to roll over its opponents. The unbeaten Yellow Jackets haven't been secured upon in their five games this season. They blasted L'Anse Creuse High, 48-0, last week.

Andover, riding a four-game win streak after losing its season-opener to Catholic Central, trounced Troy High, 33-6.

## Lahter girls keep No. 1 ranking

### Lahter girls keep No. 1 ranking

Bloomfield Hills Lahser and Farmington Our Lady of Mercy continue to top the Observer & Eccentric girls' basketball poll, but there's been a shakeup among the next five spots.

The most significant changes involved Birmingham Marian, Farmington and Birmingham Groves.

Marian (5-2 overall) moved from fifth to third place in the weekly rankings. Farmington (4-3) dropped from third to sixth, and Groves (5-2) jumped from seventh to fourth.

Marian split its games last week, losing to a very solid Regina squad Tuesday, and rebounding for an exciting overtime victory Thursday against Bishop Gallagher.

The Falcons moved up in the rankings with victories over Southfield-Lathrup and city rival Seaholm. Mary Blukowski had a game-high 24 points to highlight

Groves' two-point triumph over Lathrup.

Farmington was bumped to sixth after consecutive five-point losses to Livonia Franklin and Walled Lake Central. Walled Lake (4-4) split its games and is ranked fifth.

Lahser and Mercy, which have been running one-two in the O&E poll all season, each won two games last week to remain undefeated.

The Knights (6-0) got a big lift

from substitute center Sharon Hekker, who came off the bench to score a game-high 18 points in a win over Adams. The Marlin's (7-0) pummeled Bishop Burgess last week in a game that coach Larry Baker said "was as sharp as we've played all season."

O&E sports editors Tom Baer, Marty Budner and Dennis O'Connor are responsible for compiling the seven-team rankings. Schools in the Birmingham, Farmington, Roches-

ter, Southfield, Troy and West Bloomfield areas are eligible for the poll.
