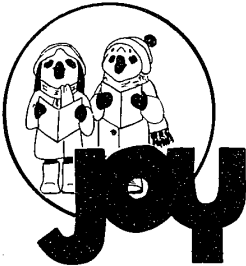

**Reye's Syndrome**

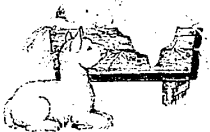
