

New unit for REO

Gross added: "Real Estate One is not new to the commercial market. It is active in the Detroit, Orlando and St. Louis markets now."

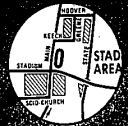
"However, moving these activities to a separate corporate entity allows our residential and commercial operations to complement each other while recognizing the distinct marketing and management requirements of each."

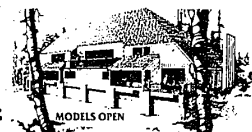
