CITY OF FARMINGTON HILLS
SUMMARY OF PROCEEDINGS
CITY COUNCIL MEETING
OCTOBER 14, 1980
The City Council of the City of Farmington Hills held a regular meeting October 14, 1980. Mayor Soronen opened the meeting at 7:30 o'clock P.M. Members present were: Burwell, Lange, Oppenheimer, Wolf, Alkateeb and Dolan. Others present were City Manager Savage, City Clerk Cairns and City Attorney. Council approved the summary of Amended Ordinance C-6-80 and enacted the Ordinance.
Council voted to take no action to reopen Tulipwood.
Approval was given the requests from Pizza Hut of America, Inc., for transfer of ownership, through merger, of 1980 Tavern licensed business, located at 32100 W. Ten Mile Road and 38300 Ten Mile Road, from Pizza Hut of Kalamazoo, Inc. Request from Rosalind A. Danver for transfer of ownership of 1980 Class C licensed business located at 23310 Eight Mile Road from Louis C. Puppo was approved. Mayor's appointment of Robert E. Benjamin to the Farmington Area Arts Commission was approved.
Council approved the settlement for a personal injury claim against the City. Upon the recommendation of the City Manager \$100,000 of the fiscal year's fund balance to be transferred to the self-insurance reserve.
\$200,000 of the fiscal year's general fund balance to be transferred to the road equipment depreciation reserve for the purpose of replacing road equipment.
\$300,000 of the fiscal year's general fund balance be reserved to establish an accumulated sick leave reimbursement reserve.
\$150,000 of the fiscal year's general fund balance be reserved to establish a road improvement reserve.
Final Plat approval of Farmington Green North No. 3 in Section 8, 93 lots was adopted.
Council denied waiver of sidewalk installation in Parkway Subdivision. Cumberland Drive was changed to Shenandoah in Farmington Green North No. 2 Subdivision, in Section 8.
Council waived the bid requirement for the purchase of special police radio equipment replacement.
Council awarded the bid for 1980 concrete pavement program to Rose Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$31,473.00 their bid being low.
Upon motion meeting adjourned.
