

# 'The Whole Person' 4-part seminar set

A four-week seminar called "The Whole Person: Body, Mind and Spirit" is sponsored by Orchard United Methodist Church and is offered to all persons in the community.

The series begins at 7 p.m. Sunday, Nov. 2. The other three sessions begin at 7:30 p.m. Mondays, Nov. 10, 17 and 24. All will be given at the church, on Farmington Road, between 13 and 14 mile roads.

Bea Ulrich, coordinator of communications for the congregation, said participants may attend any or all of the sessions. But for maximum benefit she suggests attending the entire series. Cost, for each is \$150, payable at the door.

The series leads off with "The Body's Reaction to Stress," a session headed by Dr. Eber Sherman, a physician in Eaton Rapids with special training in

holistic health. This is followed by "The Responsibility for the Health of the Whole Person" with Dr. John S. Jury. He is director of Whole Health Associates and minister of Grand Blanc United Methodist Church.

The series continues with "Coping: Biofeedback and Meditative Prayer." This session is led by Dr. Hero Singh, a clinical psychologist in Bay City, specializing in biofeedback.

The series concludes with "What We Can Do Here and Now," led by the Rev. Robert L. S. Brown and the Rev. James P. Thomas, ministers of Orchard United Methodist Church.

The entire seminar centers around the holistic health movement and points out the interrelation of body, mind and spirit.

April — "Ikebana: The Art of Japanese Flower Arrangement" with Shu-yuan Yang, Sogetsu School of Ikebana;

May 29 — "Islands of Serenity: The Art of the Japanese Garden" by Dr. Milton Baron, department of parks and planning, Michigan State University.

All programs are open to the public. General admission is \$1.50. Members of Friends of Asian Art and their friends, free.

Membership in the Friends of Asian Art is open to individuals and families interested in the study and collection of Asian art through lectures, demonstrations, study programs, tours and special events.
