

Kickers run over foe, 4-0

Sophomore Dandy Oskey scored his first goal of the year and added two assists to lead the Oakland University soccer team to a 4-0 victory over Grace College Saturday.

Oskey, last year's leading scorer with four goals and five assists in 19 games, drilled a hard shot into the upper left hand corner after taking a pass from sophomore Dave Morgan. It was the game's only second-half goal.

The Pioneers, now 11-4-2, jumped out to a 3-0 first-half lead on goals from senior Mark Christensen and freshmen Morris Lupencic and Dan Fitzgerald.

Christensen has scored a goal in each of OU's last four games and now has seven goals and four assists for the year. Lupencic tallied his 15th goal of the year at the 22:15 mark on an assist from senior Tony Hermiz.

Junior goalie Mark Hamilton of Rochester recorded his eighth shutout without making a save. OU outshot Grace, 22-1.

The Pioneers will host Ferris State College 1 p.m. Saturday in their last home game of the year before closing out the schedule at Bowling Green University 3 p.m. Nov. 5.

WOMEN'S TENNIS

Oakland's women's tennis team completed the 1980 season with a third-place finish at the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) championships in Allendale.

Freshman Kelli Jordan at No. five singles and the number three doubles team of Nancy Golding (Rochester Adams) and junior Barb Wroblewski won championships for the Pioneers and second-year coach Brad Newman.

Jordan completed her first season of collegiate tennis with a 17-2 record, winning 23 games, while losing only 133 for a 62.6 percentage.

Wroblewski, who was seeded first at No. 3 singles, lost to Wayne State's Maria Ella in the finals. She finished with a 17-2 overall record.

VOLLEYBALL

The Pioneer volleyball team won its seventh match of the season against Ferris State College, 15-7, 15-10 over the weekend.

However, the Pioneers also lost weekend matches to Hillsdale College (15-8, 15-3) and Lake Superior State College (15-9, 15-8).

The Pioneer spikers are 7-18 overall, and 3-13 in conference action. They are coached by Cecil Dodd.

CROSS COUNTRY

The OU cross country team will conclude the 1980 season at the NCAA Division II regionals starting 11 a.m. Saturday at the University of Wisconsin-Parkside.

Oakland won its first invitational of the season last weekend in Siena Heights. The Pioneers had 65 points, and Grand Valley College and Rose-Hulman Institute were right behind with 68 and 69 points, respectively.

Senior captain Steve Swarts placed fourth overall with a five-mile time of 26:33 to lead the Pioneers.

Junior Kevin Hanson (26:39) and junior Mark Carter (27:30) followed Swarts. Rounding out Oakland's five-man scoring field were sophomore Dave Schepeke and freshman John Horwarth.

Siena Heights and Spring Arbor colleges were the other participants.

Tracy shines at Pro-Am

Harrison Tracy of Birmingham, playing as a member of a three-person team, finished second in the National Team Championship Pro-Am golf tournament held recently at Walt Disney World in Orlando, Fla.

Tracy, a member of the Birmingham Country Club, teamed up with Joe Cantrell and Tom Worthing for a 47-under par for the three-day tournament. The team played three different golf courses during the tournament. Cantrell/Tracy/Worthing started with an 18 under at the Buena Vista course, shot a 13 under on the Magnolia course, and finished with a 16 under on the Palma course.

The team was matched with a pair of different pros each day. The team played with Zeno Hawley and Tony Valentine the first day, Mike Harmon and Barry Harwell the second day, and John Mahaffey and Tom Kite the third day.

The team competed in the amateur only Card Walker Tournament following the National Team Championship Pro-Am and finished first with a 16 under for 18 holes.

Both the National Team and Card Walker tournaments were best-ball tournaments.
