Senior cards available

Senior citizens can obtain identification cards for a county-wide discount program at a variety of locations in November.

The program, coordinated by the Oakland Livingston Human Service Agency (OLHSA), allows seniors, 60 years and older, to be eligible for discounts between 4 and 50 percent from participating merchants.

Items discounted range from automobile parts to prescription drugs. A directory of participating merchants is available from OLHSA for 65 cents at local senior centers.




