

Walled Lake taps Dornan manager

Farmington Hills administrator Michael Dornan has been named city manager in Walled Lake.

The Walled Lake City Council unanimously approved Dornan's application at a special meeting Monday night after quizzing the 29-year-old assistant to the Farmington Hills City manager for three hours.

"I feel positive about the council's attitude and my own attitude," said Dornan, who will take office Nov. 17.

Dornan has worked out a deal with the city council which will allow him to continue living in West Bloomfield

Township for the next seven months instead of moving to Walled Lake.

In exchange, he agreed to give council 90-day written notice if he intends to leave office.

Dornan will earn \$25,500 annually. His job performance will be reviewed every three months by city council his first year and annually thereafter.

"I think the appointment is great. City managers have assistants who go out in the field to get their feet wet. Mike will do a good job," said Lawrence Savage, Farmington Hills City Manager.

Dornan is ambivalent about leaving Farmington Hills.

"There's a psychological difference being chief administrator of a municipality," he said. "I feel thrilled."

WALLED LAKE is a community of 4,500 residents. Dornan will oversee a \$2.5 million budget. The city has the same type of council/manager plan of government as Farmington Hills.

Dornan is a graduate of Detroit Country Day High School and Hope College, where he earned a bachelor of arts degree with a major in English

and political science. He did some post-graduate work at Michigan State University in finance and accounting.

He is pursuing a master's degree in public administration at the University of Michigan.

Dornan has been employed with the city of Farmington Hills for five years. He earned \$20,000 as an assistant to Savage.

In Walled Lake, he replaces Peter Parker who was fired from the city manager's post last August. Mayor Gaspare LaMarca filled in as acting city manager until Dornan's appointment this week.
