

Girls' basketball roundup

Mercy cagers tune up for league playoffs

Farmington Our Lady of Mercy tuned up for the Catholic League girls' basketball playoffs by defeating Detroit Dominican, 77-57, in a Central Division game Tuesday night.

Mercy, now 16-0 overall and 10-0 in division play, meets Dearborn Divine Child in the first round of the playoffs at 10 p.m. Sunday at Cullen Hall on the campus of the University of Detroit.

Mercy pressed hard in the first quarter and built up a 22-10 lead. Mercy's Suzanne Dietz, a 5-foot-11 senior, scored 18 points on eight field goals and two of two free throws. Teammates Meg Mallon and Kelly Fortescue chipped in with 11 and 10 points, respectively.

Terry Kelly scored 25 points for Dominican, and Rashall Walker added 15.

Farmington Lutheran Northwest has won two games this season, and Roseville Baptist Academy has been the vic-

tim both times. The Farmington team clobbered Baptist, 74-9, Tuesday behind 24 points each by Marsha Schmidt and Donna Roberts.

IN ANOTHER game, Milford Lakeland's Sandy VanKortmolt dropped in two free throws with three seconds left to pull her team into a 44-41 tie with Farmington High. Lakeland went on to win, 52-47.

"We traded buckets in the overtime, but we made a couple of fouls and they cost us," said Farmington coach Bob Lekovich, whose team fell to 7-8 overall and 3-5 in the Inter Lakes League.

Van Remortel, a 5-6 forward, led all scorers with 19 points. Terese Saulski added nine, and Katie Cuthaw and Mary McManus each had six. Farmington center Stacy Green scored 18 points before fouling out late in the fourth quarter. Chris Looser had 10 for the Falcons.

Farmington plays next on Thursdays at Pontiac Northern. Game time is 6 p.m.

Redford Thurston, with Wendy VanSande and Sandy Nissen combining for 36 points, ripped North Farmington, 60-45, in the Northwest Suburban League. North Farmington fell to 2-14 overall and 1-7 in the conference.

"North has really improved since the last time we played them," said Thurston coach George Heger, whose team is 12-4 overall and 5-3 in the league. "They got hot in the second half and just couldn't miss a shot."

VanSande scored 19 points for the winners, and Nissen had 17. Sue Bernas scored 17 points for North, which trailed by 14 points at halftime and

then played Thurston even (32-31) in the second half.

North hosts Redford Union at 7:30 p.m. Thursday.
