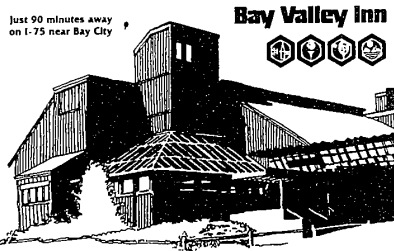

# Rice finishes on top

State-playoff contenders Birmingham Brother Rice and Farmington Harrison finished No. 1 and No. 2, respectively, in the final Observer & Eccentric football rankings for Oakland County teams.

The No. 1 Warriors advanced to the Class A state playoffs with 27-3 victory over Detroit DeLaSalle Saturday night at the Pontiac Silverdome. The triumph earned the Birmingham squad the Catholic League crown. Coach Al Fracassa's Warriors are favored to win the Class A state title as well.

No. 2 Harrison capped a perfect 9-0 season with a 38-15 slashing of Plymouth Salem. The Hawks, coached by John Herrington, finished the season with the highest computer-point total in the state-playoff history for a Class B squad. (Playoff teams are selected by a computer-point system.)

**NORTH FARMINGTON** finishes No. 3 in the ratings. The Raiders defeated Farmington High, 28-0, last Saturday to put the finishing touches

on an 8-1 season. North Farmington's only setback came two weeks ago — a 21-14 loss to Harrison.

No. 4 Auburn Hills Avondale destroyed lowly Warren Cousino, 49-0, to complete its first-ever 9-0 season. The Yellowjackets failed to make the Class B state playoffs.

Southfield Lathrup's 6-3 record is good enough for the No. 5 ranking. The Metro Suburban Activities Association co-champions defeated archrival Southfield High, 19-13, last Saturday.

**WEST BLOOMFIELD** sneaks back into the final rankings thanks to its 21-0 victory over Waterford Mott last Friday. The Lakers finished the year with a surprising 7-2 record.

Groves and Troy Athens, two teams which finished with 6-3 records, also received mention from our pollsters.
