

Meadow Brook opens 'Our Town'

Thornton Wilder's Pulitzer Prize-winning drama "Our Town" opens a four-week run at 8:30 p.m. Thursday at Meadow Brook Theatre on the Oakland University campus near Rochester.

"Our Town" is a simple and compassionate chronicle of a small New England community, Grover's Corners, during the first years of this century. In writing "Our Town," Wilder transmitted the simple events of ordinary human lives into an unusual and loving reverie touched with quiet humor and joy and hope.

Heading the cast will be Peter Brandon, who will play the role of the Stage Manager. Meadow Brook audiences

have seen Brando's performances in several productions including "The Crucible," "A Doll's House," "Who's Afraid of Virginia Woolf?" and "Born Yesterday."
